- Student engagement in scientific and engineering practices through first-hand investigations

- Overview of the new and revised components
- Effective implementation strategies for new and existing users



Who should attend?

The institute is designed for administrators, science curriculum coordinators, lead elementary teachers, and professional developers interested in starting to implement FOSS Next Generation in the 2015-16 school year. Teams of 2-4 people from schools and districts are encouraged to register and will receive priority.

The cost to attend is \$175 for individuals, or \$150 per person for those coming in teams.
