

Model A: Continental Plate Convergent Boundary


Instructions:


- 1. Place the two foam pieces together with the arrows pointing toward the center

- 2. Where do you see a plate boundary with continental crust pushing together on Earth?

Model B: Ocean Plate/Continental Plate Convergent Boundary

Instructions:

- 1. Place the foam piece and the cardboard piece next to each other with the arrows pointing at each other.
- 2. Slowly push the two pieces together and observe.

Questions:

- 1. Draw what you observed happening when you push the pieces into each other
- 2. What happens to the foam as you push it into the cardboard?
- 3. What happens to the cardboard as you push it into the foam piece?
- 4. Where do you see a plate boundary with continental crust and oceanic crust pushing together on Earth?
