

WRITING TIPS

- When using source material that is composed of sentence fragments, transform it into complete sentences that tell part of the story of that place.
- If source material is written in prose in complete sentences, transform it (in your product) into a labeled diagram, bulleted list, or other format that does NOT use complete sentences, but still contributes to the story.
- When using source material that is a data, table, graph, diagram, photo, graph, or drawing, redraw it or write an explanation in your own words to make it better suit the needs of your story.
- Consider clarity: How will you convey the information in your own words in a way that will make sense when you present it to your peers?
